



As we begin programs for children at La Casa de Cristo, we are implementing several practices to help stop the spread of COVID-19. Although we cannot guarantee that a child will not be exposed, we are taking responsible steps to help minimize the risk.

General Precautions:

- All staff and volunteers will wear face masks at all times in all areas of Ignite Kids.
- Kids ages 5yr-old through 6th grade will be required to wear a face mask while attending Ignite Kids.

If anyone is experiencing the following symptoms, we are asking them to please stay home. A child experiencing any of these symptoms will not be permitted to enter Ignite.

- Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- Upon arrival, we will be checking children's, staff and volunteer temperatures. If it is 100.4 degree F, or above they will not be permitted into Ignite.

Sanitizing:

- Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout all spaces at Ignite Kids. Children will be encouraged to frequently sanitize and/or wash their hands.
- Staff/Volunteers will routinely clean, sanitize, and disinfect surfaces and objects that are frequently touched.

Classroom Adjustments:

- The number of children in each classroom has been adjusted to help promote social distancing.
- There will not be shared supplies. Each child will have their own set of supplies at each hour. Supplies will be disinfected weekly.
- All snacks will be pre-packaged and individually wrapped.
- All children will be required to sanitize hands prior to eating snack.

Parent Drop-Off and Pick-Up:

- Parents are required be present upon arrival for temperature checks and check in.
- Ignite staff will assist with check-in to maintain a touchless environment.
- Pre-registration is required when registering for church services in order to limit capacity.
- During pick-up, parents will be asked to socially distance while waiting for their child.
