



## MOPPETS Program Policies



1. Please do not bring sick children to MOPS. Children who show signs of illness within 24 hours, such as a fever, rash, diarrhea, vomiting, coughing or green mucus from the noses cannot be accepted in the MOPPETS program that morning. The MOPPETS Coordinator will notify the mother to pick up the child immediately if the child becomes ill while in MOPPETS.
2. Please go to an iPad check-in to print child's nametag. Then you bring your child to their MOPPETS classroom; make any comments/notations needed about feeding times or special needs. This helps in case of fussiness.
3. Children should be brought to and picked up at the door by their mother.
4. Children must be picked up by 11:45 a.m. for Tuesday/Wednesday MOPS and by 8:30p.m. for TWILIGHT MOPS. Please remember that the caregivers are VOLUNTEERS. Pick up your children on time and then chat with your friends. If you child is not picked up by 11:50, the children will be taken to Room 101 and you will need to pick them up there.
5. NO medication of any kind will be given by a MOPPETS worker with the exception of epi pens. If a child must have medication, such as allergy medicine, it must be kept with the mother until needed and then given by the mother. Remember that all rooms are connected by walkie talkies and a mother can be reached in a moment's notice.
6. All bottles, blankets, diaper bags, coats, etc. must be clearly labeled. Keep personal items to a minimum.
7. Please use only disposable diapers when your child is in MOPPETS.

8. Bring a sufficient number of diapers, remembering that some days are wetter than others. If the child is in training pants, a complete change of clothes is helpful.
9. Mothers should refrain from checking on their children during the session. It upsets the children to see people come and go from their classrooms. Mothers will be notified immediately if they are needed. Cara will have all cell phone numbers. Occasionally she will try to text you pictures of your children in Moppets.
10. If your child develops a communicable disease, such as chicken pox, strep throat, etc. please notify Cara Hoffman at 480-948-1234 ext. 1221.
11. Please REMEMBER THE MEETINGS are for mothers. Unless your child is nursing or sleeping, please check them into the appropriate classroom. All children 6 months and older must be enrolled in MOPPETS. When your child reaches 6 months, please contact Cara Hoffman at 480-948-1234 ext. 1221 to enroll them in MOPPETS. Children 6 months and under are welcome in MOPPETS, but must be registered.
12. Children 2 and older should receive a "take home" card each MOPS meeting. When you pick up your child, if they do not have this card, be sure to ask the MOPPETS caregivers.
13. To use the MOPPETS program, you must attend MOPS meetings. Never drop your children off in the classrooms and then leave the campus.
14. Please don't forget to apply sunscreen before you leave home!
