

**Memorial Garden** 



The Memorial Garden is a lovely, peaceful columbarium with approximately 400 niches and 100 crypts to hold the ashes or remains of the departed. A Scatter Garden is also available. The Memorial Garden is enhanced by seasonal flowers and the calming effects of water cascading from the fountain. Here family and friends can sit in quiet remembrance of their loved ones. The strength of Christ's presence enfolds you as the Saints of the Church become a legacy of His love and promise for eternal life.

**Space in the Garden is available to** anyone wishing to rest in the shadow of the cross.

Prearranging is an important step in establishing your wishes at an extremely emotional time for family, yet crucial in creating a lasting tribute. Planning ahead gives families peace of mind and an opportunity to talk together about a meaningful celebration of a life well lived.

**Niches** are for cremated human remains. They are built into the walls of the building and are fronted by elegant polished stone panels. The dimensions are 10" high – 11 7/16" wide – 11 1/2" deep. They are designed to hold two urns if they are the appropriate size (5 1/2" x 5 1/2" x 7").

**Crypts** are designed to hold a single casket. Dimensions are 86" long – 30" wide and 26" deep. Following a casketed entombment, the crypt is sealed and a travertine front is attached. Crypt tile dimensions are 28 13/16" high– 35 6/16 wide.

**The Scatter Garden** is a dedicated area within the Garden where cremated human remains are scattered freely and a memorial plaque erected.

**Cremation** is consistent with the Christian belief that the physical body returns to the dust from which it came and that a new body is given by God in the Resurrection.

Prices for niches and crypts vary based on their location.

## **OTHER FEES**

**Opening and Closing Fees** the expense of opening and closing the niches and crypts. Niches \$200. Crypts \$650.

Endowed Care Fee is a national industry standard that requires funds be set aside for the long-term care of the columbarium facility. The one-time endowment fee guarantees that funds are available in perpetuity to continue all required maintenance and repair. The Endowed Care Fee ensures the La Casa de Cristo Memorial Garden will always be presented as it is today. Niches \$175. Crypts \$375.

Engraving Fee covers the cost of engraving the La Casa de Cristo dove or cross on each stone, along with the name and dates.
Engraving fees vary for a niche and a crypt.
Fees do not pertain to the Scatter Garden where the plaque is included in the cost.
Niches \$250.
Crypts \$1000.
