TOUR ITINERARY

Saturday, May 2 - Depart PHX

Depart from Phoenix and fly to Amman, Jordan.

Sunday, May 3 - Arrive AMM

Arrive at Queen Alia Airport, after visa formalities transfer to hotel in Amman. Overnight in Amman.

Monday, May 4 - Amman

Welcome to the historic city of Amman! You will visit the Amman Citadel, Jordan Archaeological Museum, and the ancient Roman Theater. Then, visit Madaba and Mt. Nebo where Moses gave his final farewell before the Israelites crossed the Jordan into the Promised Land. (B,D)

Tuesday, May 5 - Wadi Rum

Follow the path of Lawerence of Arabia and go on a 4x4 bedouin adventure through the breathtaking red-sand Wadi Rum desert. That evening you will get a true taste of Jordanian desert nights in special accommodations like no other. (B,D)



Wednesday, May 6 - Petra

Spend a full day at the world-renowned Nabatean wonder of Petra. We walk along the narrow gorge of the Siq and see the rose-red carved stone. We pass the theater, visit the church, temples, and the famous tombs. Those that desire can walk all the way up to the Ad Deir Monastery for a spectacular view in this world-renowned location. (B,D)

Thursday, May 7 - Jordan River, Dead Sea

Touch the waters of the Jordan River at Al-Maghtas, where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist. Proceed into Israel and head to the Ein Boqeq area to experience the lowest land destination on earth, the Dead Sea. (B,D)

Friday, May 8 - Masada, Ein Gedi

Take a cable car up to the top of Herod's dramatic clifftop fortress of Masada overlooking the Dead Sea landscape. Walk the plateau of the holdout of the Jews against the 1st century Roman siege and see the remains of their presence. Continue on to the nature sanctuary of Ein Gedi where David went when he fled from Saul (1 Samuel 24). Enjoy the beauty of the waterfalls and wildlife in this tucked-away natural oasis. (B,D)

Saturday, May 9 - Qumran, Jericho

Explore the ruins of Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Visit one of the oldest cities in the world: Jericho. See the land where the Israelites famously encircled the city and made the walls come tumbling down. Take a cable car to the Mt. Of Temptation and visit St. George's Monastery. Note: if monastery entry is permitted there is a strict dress code: no shorts for men; no trousers of any sort for women; women must wear a long skirt and a modest top. (B,D)

Sunday, May 10 - Galilee

Enjoy a boat ride on the beautiful Sea of Galilee and see the settings of Jesus' ministry. See where Christ walked on land and water! See the famous "Galilee Boat". Visit the important New Testament locations of Magdala, Tabgha, Kursi, and Jesus's home base of Capernaum. We will also enjoy a traditional St. Peter's Fish Lunch while traveling through Galilee. (B,L,D)

Monday, May 11 - Galilee

Continue your explorations of the New Testament stories at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the sermon on the mount and Caesarea Philippi, where Jesus speaks to his disciples with the question, "Who do you say that I am?". See the impressive remains of Galilean Charazin. Then, enter into the stories of the Old Testament and see the remains of ancient Dan and Hazor. (B,D)

Tuesday, May 12 - Galilee

Visit the sites of Jesus' hometown: Nazareth. See the modern town and the Basilica of Annunciation as well as a reconstructed Nazareth village from 2,000 years ago. You will learn all about the setting of Jesus' upbringing, including touring the nearby Roman city of Sepphoris. You will also see Cana, the site of Jesus' first Biblical miracle. (B,D)

Wednesday, May 13 - Jerusalem

Welcome to Jerusalem. Start out with a spectacular view from the Mount of Olives overlooking this monumental city. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension where Jesus ascended into heaven after his ministry on earth. Then, journey down a spiritual path towards the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of all Nations. Proceed into the Jerusalem walls through Stephen's Gate to visit the pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed a paralyzed man (John 5:1-9), and St Anne's Church near the Via Dolorosa. (B,D)

Thursday, May 14 - Jerusalem

Visit the House of Caiaphas, traditionally identified with the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, commemorating where Jesus was held overnight before being taken before Pilate. Then, step back in time and take in the City of King David. Walk through the adventurous Hezekiah's Tunnel, see the Pool of Siloam, and explore the Herodian Wall and the Western Wall Tunnels. (B,D)

Friday, May 15 - Jerusalem

Continue your visit of the Holy City of Jerusalem by seeing the sites of Jesus' path to the cross: the Upper Room and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the most sacred site in Jerusalem, marking the location of Jesus' crucifixion, burial, and resurrection. Visit the Temple Mount, the Old City Wall Walk, the Jewish Quarter, and the Wohl Museum. (B,D)

Saturday, May 16 - Bethlehem

Continue on to Bethlehem to celebrate Jesus' birth with a visit to the Church of the Nativity and the Shepherd's Fields. Visit St. Jerome's Cave, where the early church father lived and translated the Bible into Latin. Enjoy a special lunch with a true taste of the middle east. See the impressive fortress of Herodium and Rachel's tomb, the beloved wife of Jacob. (B,L,D)

Sunday, May 17 - Depart TLV

Transfer to the Tel Aviv Airport, fly back to Phoenix. *All sites are subject to change based on real-time accessibility.
